Extra entry requirements Visual Anthropology

- Prior education or demonstrate thorough practical knowledge in filming and editing.
 - Reason: you need to be self-sufficient in technical terms
 - You show this by submitting a portfolio (view for more information [this website](#))
- You must be able to demonstrate that you have sufficient training and knowledge in visual anthropology
- All other entry requirements that apply to the other tracks apply here as well



Application deadlines Visual Anthropology Track

- If pre-Master: then you apply at for the Cult and Soc Anthropology track in feb 2022. You indicate in your motivation letter that you wish to apply for the visual track and send in a portfolio. [More info](#)
- No pre-master is needed: apply in Feb 2023. The application will be open from Oct 2022 onwards.
