How do you get enrolled for the courses?

- Study advisor emails you in the [enrollment period](#)
- Check the letter from the admissions office for the exact entry requirements *so that you will be enrolled for the right courses!*
- Make sure you read your email (address known to UvA)
- At the end of the programme: we check did you meet the entry requirements
- If yes: you will be admitted unconditionally.

Application deadlines Visual Anthropology Track

- If pre-Master: then you apply at for the Cult and Soc Anthropology track in feb 2022. You indicate in your motivation letter that you wish to apply for the visual track and send in a portfolio. *Please read the website information carefully!* [Here](#)
- You have an Anthropology + Visual Anthropology background and no pre-master is needed: apply in Feb 2023. The application will be open from Oct 2022 onwards [more info](#).
- Track increasingly becomes selective, so sometimes good to consider postponing your application to first get more training.

Extra entry requirements Visual Anthropology

- **All other entry requirements also apply**, keep in mind that this is first and foremost a master programme in the academic discipline of Anthropology. *Crucial question: are you interested in Anthropology?*
- Prior education or demonstrate thorough practical knowledge in filming and editing.
 - Reason: you need to be self-sufficient in technical terms
 - You show this by submitting a portfolio (view for more information [this website](#))
- You must be able to demonstrate that you have sufficient training and knowledge in visual anthropology
