Apply now for an Erasmus+ short-term, blended exchange programme at the University of Amsterdam (UvA), Economics and Business (EB).

What?

The Amsterdam Sustainability Challenge is a blended course, combining three preparatory online meetings with a project-based programme in Amsterdam.

When?

The course is taught in the first semester. Once the exact data have been determined, you will be informed about this.

- Online: November - December
- On-campus: January

Who?

Bachelor's students with at least 90 EC in Economics or Business related courses.

How to apply?

Contact your home university for information about how and when to apply. If you are selected, the UvA Exchange Office will contact you about your registration.

Why apply for this programme?

1. Gain international experience: chance to go on a short-term exchange. Get to know Amsterdam and the Dutch culture.
2. Project-based programme: expand your knowledge on sustainability research and develop your consultancy skills. Participate in a sustainability project in cooperation with leading Amsterdam-based companies.
3. Interdisciplinary perspective: form evidence-based judgement from multiple perspectives (economics, environmental, ethical).
4. International classroom: develop your interpersonal and intercultural skills.
5. Social activities: get to know students from all over the world and expand your network.
