REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

You will have to submit a variety of documents along with your application. Please note that the Admissions Office will only process complete applications. Use the table below as a quick reference to see which document requirements apply to you. Are you a Bachelor's student in "Sociale Geografie en Planologie" or "Sociologie" or "Politologie" at the University of Amsterdam and do you graduate before 1 September? Then you do not need to submit an application via SIS when you are applying to the corresponding Master's programme. The same applies to UvA Bachelor's students in "Interdisciplinaire Sociale Wetenschap" who wish to apply to our MSc programme Sociology. Your enrollment will become definitive as soon as the UvA has registered your graduation. Your graduation date must be no later than 31 August in order to be able to start the Master's programme on 1 September.

Explanation of the local grading and credit system	If non-Dutch higher education.
Higher education diploma(s)/final transcripts	For all applicants and if already obtained.
Course descriptions	For all applicants, except Bachelor's students of the College of Social Sciences.
Research questions	For all applicants, except when applying to Sociology and Research Master Urban Studies.
English language test score OR waiver request	If English is not your first language. Please see our website for more information on possible exemptions.
Description of any relevant English language experience since the English test was taken	If English language test score is more than 2 years old.
Sample of Academic Writing (please see 'Documents Explained' for more information on the details regarding academic writing sample)	For all applicants.
Link to Portfolio	For Visual Anthropology track.
Names and contact details of two referees	For all applicants. Only if the Admissions Board deems it necessary, we will contact the referees for reference letters. If you already have reference letters, you may upload them to your application.

Official higher education transcripts (final) and diploma(s): by e-mail sent by your university directly to apply-gsss@uva.nl , or through an online verification system. If it is not possible to send the certified documents digitally, please ask us by e-mail (to apply-gsss@uva.nl) how we wish to receive your documents.	For all applicants except when graduated from a Dutch university.
Translations of transcripts and diploma(s) by a sworn translator: please ask us by e-mail (to apply-gsss@uva.nl) how we wish to receive your translations.	If transcripts and diplomas in any other language than English, Dutch, German, or French.

Please make sure that your application is complete before you submit it. Everything the Admissions Board will need to assess your application should be filled in and uploaded before you submit. You will need to do a thorough check yourself to make sure that you have uploaded all required documents and provided all necessary information.
