

Master Medical Informatics

MSc Medical Informatics is a two-year Master's degree programme taught in English. It is open to both direct entrants from BSc Medical Informatics and lateral entrants with related first degrees. The latter can come from a variety of backgrounds, including Medicine, Health Sciences, Biomedical Sciences, Computer Science and relevant vocational degree courses. To join the course, you must comply with the prerequisites listed on the website of the University of Amsterdam by visiting the page application and admission on www.uva.nl/onderwijs/master/masteropleidingen/item/medical-informatics.html. Application for International students

Each academic year, there are two starting dates for the Master study MI: 1st of September and 1st of February. The conversion programme has a maximum length of 26 EC, corresponding with 6 to 8 months of prior study time. Students not currently resident in the Netherlands are advised to apply one year before the starting date. Although the maximum length of a conversion programme to meet the prerequisites is 26 EC, there is also time needed for preparing practical matters, as housing and a possible visa.

All prospective lateral entrants must apply in advance by completing this registration form and sending it to the Examination Board for consideration, enclosing the following documents:

- a) A letter of application, including reasons for wishing to take the course.
- b) Reference letter(s).
- c) Certified copies of relevant qualifications (Bachelor's and/or Master's degree certificates).
- d) A list of courses or modules taken, graduate points and marks obtained.
- e) A curriculum vitae describing the candidate's educational and employment history, as well as any additional courses taken.
- f) Certified copy of English language proficiency (when applicable).
- g) Proof of the institution where you followed the bachelor's program, in case of a study delay (with a maximum of 15 EC) due to the Corona crisis which have occurred in the second semester of the third year of the Bachelor's program.

The admission procedure also includes an interview.
