

The VU has a document containing rules for taking exams in common examination rooms, including the 'TenT'. Some of these rules deviate from what we are used to at FNWI (UvA). Here are some of the most notable differences:

1. VU: Students who arrive late will have to wait in a waiting room. After 30 minutes everyone from the waiting room will be admitted to the exam room (4.3).
UvA: you are allowed access to the exam room until 30 minutes after the start of the exam t (4.3 lid 8).
2. VU: When the invigilator gives permission and never earlier than one-and-a-half-hour after the start of the exam or later than 15 minutes before the end of the exam, a visit to the toilet is permitted (4.5 and 5.1).
UvA: When the invigilator gives permission and never earlier than half an hour after the start of the exam or later than 15 minutes before the end of the exam, a visit to the toilet is permitted (4.3 lid 9 and 13).
3. VU: Students are not allowed to eat during exams, , but drinking is allowed (6).
UvA: The RRvE says nothing about eating/ drinking but in practice students are always allowed to eat and/or drink during exams, except in rooms where computers are present at the tables.
4. VU: It is not allowed to take exam assignments home after a students has finished an exam. This rule is not stated in the general regulations, but it is upheld in practice. .
UvA: It is allowed to take home exam assignments, unless stated otherwise on the cover sheet (Rights and Duties of a Student).
5. VU: Often there is not a lecturer present during an exam . If there are questions from students about the exam, the teacher has to be called (7.8).
UvA: In practice there is always a lecturer present in case students have questions about the exam . However, the RRvE does not include anything about this. .
