

INTERVIEWERS FOR RESEARCH IN COFFEESHOPS

The Bonger Institute of Criminology is a multidisciplinary research institute at the Faculty of Law of the UvA. Currently, we participate in a European research project on Illicit Drugs Policies (IDPSO). Part of the research is a survey among 1000 cannabis users residing in 7 different countries (The Netherlands, France, Italy, Portugal, UK, Canada, Australia). These users will be contacted and interviewed in coffeeshops in Amsterdam or elsewhere in the Netherlands.

Your Task / Responsibilities

- Approaching coffeeshop visitors in different coffeeshops.
- Recruiting participants into the study and interviewing them.

Requirements

- Native-level speaker in one or more of the following languages: Dutch, English, French, Italian and/or Portuguese.
- Currently enrolled student at a university in Amsterdam (Bachelor at least at the 2nd year of study, or Master).
- Legal status that allows you to work in the Netherlands: EU-nationality, or valid Dutch residence permit and working permit in the Netherlands. BSN is required.
- Familiar with coffeeshops.
- Strong communication skills.
- Prior relevant field work/interview experience is a plus.
- Well organized, able to work effectively autonomously.
- Capable of working flexibly regarding days, hours, locations.
- Available from mid-January till early April 2019.
