
Money Matters

While you can't put a price on knowledge, **studying certainly doesn't come cheap**. Expect to spend about \bigcirc 975- \bigcirc 1,500 a month on living expenses alone, tuition fees not included. On our website you can find a <u>rough breakdown</u> so you can prepare financially.

Several scholarships and loans are available to UvA students for them to finance their tuition and living expenses while studying in the Netherlands. If you wish to apply, **please note that there are deadlines**. Also, consider it may take multiple weeks to complete applications, and that some must be applied for while you're still in your home country.
