

Opening a Dutch bank account

Once in the Netherlands, you might find it helpful to open a Dutch bank account. International money transfers can be expensive, and credit cards are not widely accepted. **A Dutch debit card allows you to pay** at supermarkets, cafes and restaurants easily and free of charge.

Student finance DUO

A Dutch term you will probably hear a lot throughout your studies is *stufi*, the abbreviation for studiefinanciering (student finance). **You might be eligible for student finance from the Dutch government**. Whether you qualify for these loans depends on your nationality or residency status, age and study programme. Do check your eligibility to not miss out.
