The Executive Board of the University of Amsterdam (UvA) received the final report of the research review of Psychology 2017, at nine universities: the University of Amsterdam, Erasmus University Rotterdam, Leiden University, Open University of the Netherlands, University of Groningen, Maastricht University, Tilburg University, Utrecht University and VU Amsterdam. An international peer review committee carried out the evaluation in September 2017, using the Standard Evaluation Protocol 2015-2021. The Psychology Research Institute Amsterdam (RIPA) of UvA was evaluated by the peer review committee.

The Executive Board wishes to thank the peer review committee, chaired by prof. em. Eddy van Avermaet, for carrying out the evaluation. The Executive Board is very pleased that the committee assessed the research quality, relevance to society and viability of RIPA to be excellent.

The Executive Board received a response from the dean of the Faculty of Social and Behavioural Sciences to the evaluation report and supports the faculty in using the recommendations to further enhance the performance of the institute.
