

Manual Prestige software

Wouter de Nooy; last update 24/01/2006; Prestige version 0.1

This manual explains the operation of the software program Prestige which calculates an index of dynamic prestige from a network data file containing dated transitions. The principles of dynamic prestige are explained in the article 'The dynamics of artistic prestige' by Wouter de Nooy, published in *Poetics*, 30 (2002) 3, 147-167. The software was developed for the analysis reported there.

Input data

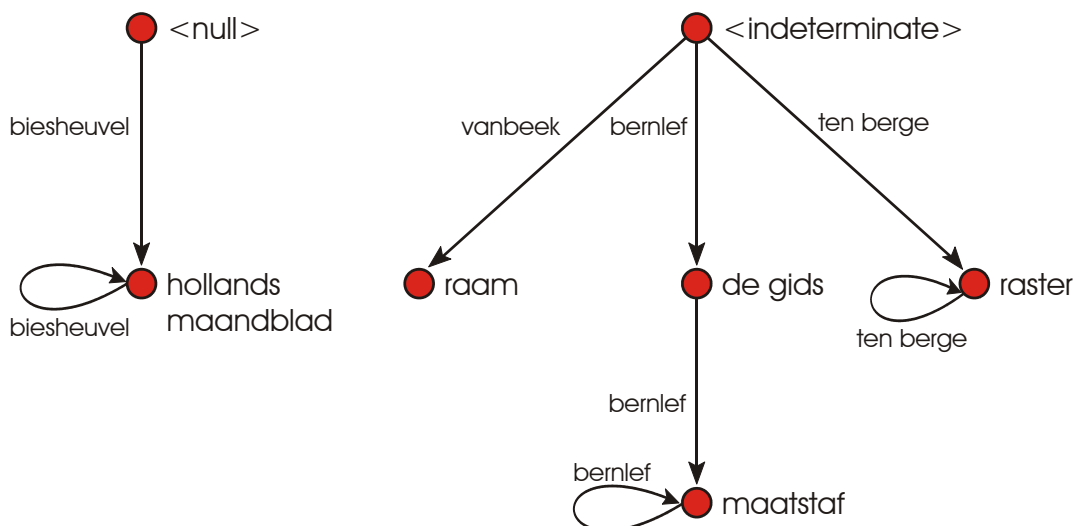


Figure 1 - Example of a transition network.

The software operates on a network of transitions or steps. A transition or a step is defined as the move of an agent from one location to another. Usually, agents are persons and locations are organizations, so the basic data are 2-mode data, affiliations. Note however, that the input network is a 1-mode network, containing the locations (organizations) as the vertices (nodes), with the transitions as the arcs, which are labelled by the agent (person) that performs the transition. Figure 1 shows an example of a transition network in a particular period. Vertices represent literary magazines or virtual locations (explained below), arcs represent transitions by authors from one magazine (or location) to another. E.g., Bernlef had his first publication in the magazine *De Gids* in this period, then published in *Maatstaf* and finally published again in the latter magazine.

In addition, the transitions or steps are dated, they have a time stamp. Time stamps are represented by integers, not complete dates. Time stamps may start with one or a higher integer. The time stamp must refer to the time at which the agent enters the (new) location, e.g., the moment at which s/he starts a new affiliation or renews an existing affiliation to an organization. It is up to the investigator to decide whether continued affiliations must be taken into account; if so, transitions from the organization to itself

(loops) should be present at any of the time points. If not, the transition from this organization to the next should only be included in the dataset. Note that the affiliations in the example of Figure 1 are publications in literary magazines, which are incidental (not regulated by a contract for a longer period) by nature. Other types of affiliations, however, may be stable, e.g., a position (job) at an organization.

The data must pertain to affiliations to a set of organizations (locations) over a period of time. The period must contain a substantial number of affiliations and transitions over a considerable number of time points because the index of dynamic prestige requires an array of observations to obtain a stable state. There are no guidelines available for the length of the period and the number of transitions required for obtaining a stable state; this is to be determined in the empirical application.

In addition to the real locations (organizations), there are two virtual locations: the null location (incubator or graveyard) and the indeterminate location (see Figure 1). When an agent obtains a first affiliation to an organization, that is, at the start of the agent's career, s/he makes a transition from 'nowhere' to his or her first location. The program uses the virtual null location as the starting point of the transition. The prestige of this starting point is fixed at zero. In the example, we know that Biesheuvel's publication was his very first. Similarly, the transition away from the agent's last location is represented by an arc from the last organization to the virtual null location. Note, however, that the incubator or graveyard concept is not necessarily relevant to all types of careers, e.g., in the case of free lance or incidental affiliations such as publishing a text in a literary magazine, it is better not to use the graveyard location because each publication (affiliation) is normally followed by a time without publications.

The indeterminate location is used when an agent enters the investigated system of locations from locations or times not studied or leaves the system but continues the career at locations or times not studied. Indeterminate merely stands for "we don't know where they come from or go to." The unknown organizations are disregarded in calculating dynamic prestige instead of assuming that they have minimum (zero) prestige. This is the case for Bernlef and Ten Berge in the example of Figure 1.

The network of transitions must be in Pajek arcs/edges format, including the agents' names as labels to the arcs. Chapter 1 and Appendix 1 in *Exploratory Social Network Analysis with Pajek* by De Nooy, Mrvar and Batagelj (Cambridge University Press, 2005) explain this data format. Section 4.5 of the book explains the use of time indicators in Pajek network data files. Labels to arcs or edges are represented by the key letter l (of label) followed by the label between double quotation marks "" (don't include double quotation marks in the label itself).

Below is a partial listing of the literary magazines network data analyzed in 'The dynamics of artistic prestige' (*Poetics*, 30 (2002) 3, 147-167); <etcetera> replaces skipped parts. The entire network data file is displayed in Appendix 1; save it as a plain text file if you want to use it as a test dataset with the Prestige software.

Figure 1 graphically displays the arcs of this example, omitting magazines that are not included in these arcs. Note that the time stamp of the arcs is [1], so the figure displays just one period (actually, this is the year 1970). Some magazines appear later in the period, e.g., *Bzzlletin*, which was first published in 1974 (time [5]), or disappear, e.g., *Raam*, which was last published in 1975 (time [6]). The asterisk in time stamps represent infinity, which means that they exist at least until the end of the period under investigation.

Using the Prestige program

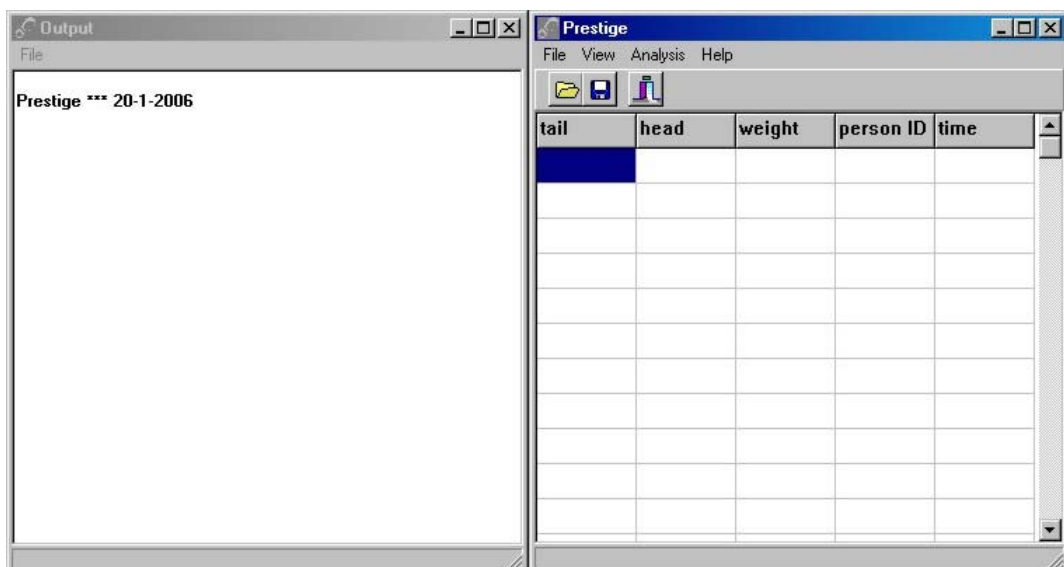


Figure 2 - The interface of the Prestige program.

Once started, the program displays two windows, the data interface and the results window (Figure 2). You can load a network of transitions with the *Open* command in the *File* menu.

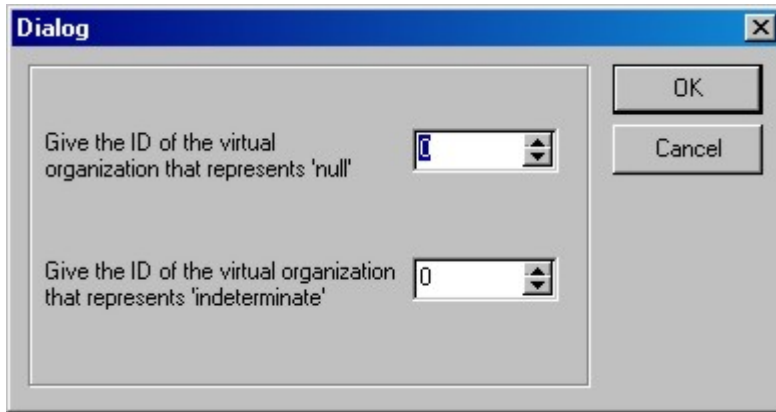


Figure 3 - Dialog box for the identification of virtual locations.

On selection of a network data file, a dialog box (Figure 3) asks for the (vertex) numbers of the virtual locations: the null and indeterminate locations (explained above). If they occur, enter their numbers here. Otherwise, leave the value zero as the entry, so virtual

locations will be ignored. Note that Pajek numbers vertices from 1, so vertex number zero cannot exist. If the network data file is correctly loaded, the arcs are displayed in the grid. You may edit the data manually in the grid although this is a little cumbersome because you will get an error message if you delete or overwrite the entire number in a cell. The output screen will display the locations and actors that it encountered in the data set.

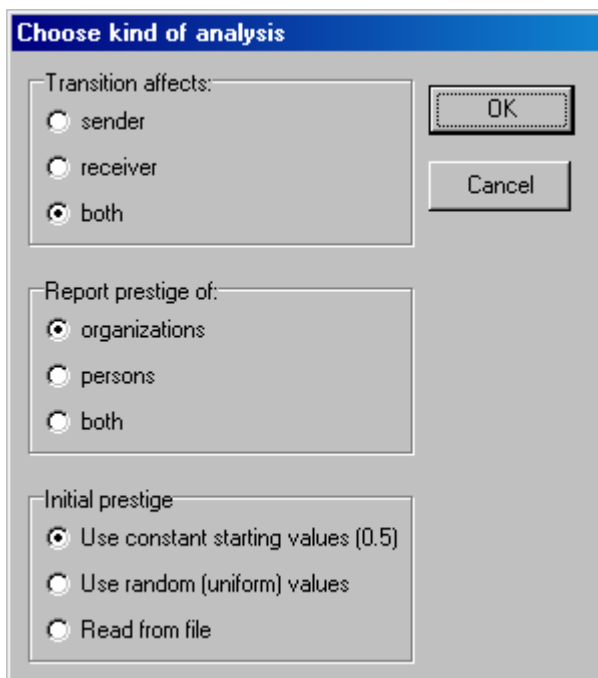


Figure 4 - Dialog box with options for calculating dynamic prestige.

The final step consists of having the software calculate the index of dynamic prestige. Selecting the *Analyze prestige* command in the *Analyze* menu will open a dialog box in which you can make some choices (Figure 4).

The first choice concerns the way in which you want to calculate dynamic prestige (*Transition affects:*). The move by an actor from one location (sender) to another (receiver) may have an impact on the prestige of the sending location, the receiving location, or on both. If the *sender* option is checked, the new prestige of a location (at $t+1$) is calculated as the average prestige of the locations (at time t) to which the location's members (at time t) go at the next time point ($t+1$). In other words, where do

my former members go? If they move to locations with currently a higher prestige, my location's prestige increases (at $t+1$). Choosing option *receiver*, the new prestige of a location (at time $t+1$) is calculated as the average prestige score of the locations from which it's members at the new time point ($t+1$) come. In other words, where do my current members come from? Finally, the option *both* takes into account both types of effects, that is, both where my former members have gone and where my current members came from.

The second choice pertains to the output: do you want to have the calculated dynamic prestige for the locations (*organizations*), or the actors (*persons*), or both. With the third choice, the user can specify the initial prestige scores of the locations, that is, the assumed values at time $t=0$.

The first option automatically uses constant starting values of dynamic prestige (0.5) for all locations that exist at (or before) time point one. Locations marked as virtual (null and indeterminate) in a previous step, automatically receive an initial prestige score of zero.

The second option produces random initial prestige values. Again, virtual locations and locations that do not exist yet at time $t=0$ have zero initial prestige.

With the third option (*Read from file*), the user may select a data file containing pre-specified starting values for dynamic prestige (at time $t=0$). This file should be a plain text file in Pajek vector format (see our book, Section 2.5), that is, an initial vertices statement specifying the number of locations (which should be equal to the vertices statement in the network data file), followed by the initial prestige values, each on a separate line and without blank lines. The vertices statement is not necessary.

Note that all initial prestige values should be in the range from zero to one. A point is the standard decimal separator (but the Windows language setting may interfere with this). It is up to the user to decide whether virtual locations and locations that do not exist yet at the first time point for which transitions are available (not necessarily $t=1$) must get initial prestige of zero or another number.

Reading the output

The output window reports the decisions made while selecting data files and issuing commands. It lists the organizations read from the network data file with the first and last time points as specified in the file. Then it lists the labels and first appearances of the actors with their sequential number (starting with 0). After issuing the analysis command, the output window shows a table with locations in the rows and the time points in the columns, showing the initial and calculated prestige scores.

The output file can be saved in Rich Text File format with the *Save* or *Save As* commands in the *File* menu of the output window. The columns are separated by tabs, so it is fairly easy to transform it into a table in word-processing software. At present, there is no option to save the calculated prestige scores in a different format.
